

PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy discloses the privacy practices for www.kosudunyamiz.com, effective January 24, 2016. This privacy policy applies solely to information collected by this web site and will notify you of the following:

- (i) What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the web site, how it is used and with whom it may be shared.
- (ii) What choices are available to you regarding the use of your data.
- (iii) The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
- (iv) Online tracking procedures by this website.
- (v) Our compliance under the California Online Privacy Protection Act, including third party track signals and third party behavioral tracking.
- (vi) Our non marketing to children under 13 years of age under the Children Online Privacy Protection Act

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to/collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

The information we collect may include the following:

- Your name
- Home address
- Telephone Numbers (home and mobile)
- Email Address
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Fitness and health information, such as athletic goals and present fitness levels relating to running and athletic performance

We will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us. We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request, e.g. to ship an order or provide online fitness coaching services. Unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via email or mail in the future to tell you about specials, new products or services, or changes to this privacy policy.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

You may opt out of any future contacts from us at any time. You can do the following at any time by contacting us via the email address or phone number given on our website in order to:

- See what data we have about you, if any.
- Change/correct any data we have about you.
- Have us delete any data we have about you.
- Express any concern you have about our use of your data.

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline. Wherever we collect sensitive information (such as credit card data), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a closed lock icon at the bottom of your web browser, or looking for "https" at the beginning of the address of the web page.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, billing or customer service) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

Online Tracking

Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the site's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. We use cookies to:
